GUIDELINES FOR ATTENDING THE NORTHEAST FARMERS MARKET

The Northeast Farmers Market provides a 10' x 10' space, tent, tent weights, table and chairs for your scheduled Saturday. Work out arrival time with the Market Manager, who will be on site to assist you. You may pull your vehicle into the parking lot to unload. After you unload, park on the surrounding Streets or Avenues.

The Northeast Farmers Market is open every Saturday, rain or shine, May 14th – October 15th, 2022 from 9:00am-1:00pm in the parking lot of St. Boniface Church. In case of severe weather, the market will be cancelled. The Market Manager will notify you of a cancellation.

Tent Policies:

- You may sign people up for an email list as communication for fundraising.
- You may pass out information about your organization and about future events.
- You may give away items to promote your organization, ie., pencils, bags, etc.
- You may set up activities that are family friendly to engage customers. Please no giving away of candy, food or drink of any kind.
- No fundraising/solicitation of donations allowed on site.
- No political parties or proselytizing.
- Products asked to be sold at the market by the organization will be evaluated by the Market Board and Manager on a case-by-case basis.
